CORE regional allocation is managed by Routt County. Routt County also has a county only CORE allocation. Services provided with this contract would be paid with the Routt County funds first. If overspent, the regional dollars would cover. Our county Core allocation is \$159,390 and total is \$338,390.52. We are not expected to over spend the total allocation.

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V. BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

CORE funds are used to provide services for families involved in Child Welfare. The goal of the funds is to reduce the risk of out of home placement for youth. CORE funds are often used to provide therapeutic services for families that do not have access to therapy through Medicaid or private health insurance. Routt spends the majority of funds on the Day Treatment Alternative program. By having different contracts with a variety of providers, we can access services for our families more appropriately and timely.
