VI. LEGAL ISSUES:

Temporary easements will not create permanent encumbrance to the county owned parcel beyond the potential maintenance requirements associated with a minor 1-2ft wall intended to preserve a large mature spruce tree. The easement dedication agreement will not be recorded and its term will expire upon completion of the proposed project.
