V. BACKGROUND INFORMATION:
<p>The equipment and software approved by the BCC for the 2 Motorola MCC7100 remote dispatch radio positions on March 26, 2019 is typically designed for and sold to be utilized outside of the fixed environment, such as a Mobile Communications Vehicle, EOC, etc. Last year, Motorola Solutions presented several design options and configurations for consideration. Through our budget process last year, the BCC approved the remote dispatch console option because of the flexibility. While we relayed to Motorola Solutions that our intent was to utilize these workstations on a desk and be able to grab and go if needed, there was miscommunication about the fact that our desire was to use them in a semi-permanent installation in the dispatch room.</p> <p>There were some components and parts not included in the proposal and approval by the BCC on March 26. The missing pieces are one AIM (Audio Interface Module) for each of the 2 new dispatch workstations, headset jacks which will allow integration with the 911 telephone system, foot pedals for talking on the radio, a desktop microphone, and desktop speakers. The equipment will not work in a most efficient manner the way we want them to inside the dispatch center without these components.</p> <p>These parts/components are part of the State of Colorado Price Agreement (SPA) 2016-160/NASPO effective through 6/30/19.</p>
