RESOLUTION NO. 2019-

**A RESOLUTION PURSUANT TO C.R.S. § 42-4-106 AUTHORIZING
THE CLOSURE OF ROUTT COUNTY ROAD 18**

RECITALS:

A. C.R.S. § 42-4-106 authorizes local authorities, including counties, when acting with respect to highways under their jurisdiction, to prohibit the operation of vehicles upon any such highway or impose restrictions as to the weight of vehicles to be operated upon any such highways, for up to a total period of ninety days in any one calendar year, when the highway in question will be seriously damaged or destroyed due to deterioration, rain, snow or other climatic condition unless the use of such highway is so restricted.

B. On May 2, 1995, the Board of County Commissioners of Routt County, Colorado (the "Board") adopted Resolution No. 95-27 establishing a procedure by which the Board's powers pursuant to C.R.S. § 42-4-106 could be expeditiously exercised, delegating the Board's authority under C.R.S. § 42-4-106 to the Routt County Road and Bridge Director (the "Director"), and setting forth the standards under which said delegated authority is to be exercised.

C. In accordance with the criteria established in Resolution No. 95-27, the Director has determined that Routt County Road 18 (Sarvis Creek) ("RCR 18"), from Stagecoach Reservoir to the gate at Pleasant Valley, is in immediate and probable danger of sustaining significant damage or is likely to be destroyed due to deterioration unless the use of the road is temporarily restricted to all motor vehicle traffic.

D. Pursuant to the exercise of authority granted to Director by Resolution No. 95-27, Director has notified the Board of his decision to temporarily close RCR 18 for a period of less than 90 days, beginning May 1, 2019 until RCR 18 is no longer in danger of damage from motor vehicle traffic and has placed confirmation of Director's decision on the Board's agenda for May7, 2019. In addition, notice of the closure of RCR 18 has been posted on the road, posted at the places specified for public notices and provided to all local newspapers, radio stations and television stations.

E. The Board finds that the Director has appropriately exercised the authority granted under C.R.S. § 42-4-106 as delegated to him by the Board pursuant to Resolution No. 95-27 and that the Director has complied with the criteria and notification requirements set forth in Resolution No. 95-27.

F. Based upon the recommendation of the Director and the foregoing information, the Board wishes to confirm the Director's decision to close RCR 18.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board as follows:

The Board hereby confirms the Director's decision to temporarily close Routt County Road 18 (Sarvis Creek), from Stagecoach Reservoir to the gate at Pleasant Valley, to motor vehicle traffic, other than emergency and law enforcement vehicles, beginning May 1, 2019 until no longer in danger of damage from motor vehicle traffic, which shall be for a period of less than 90 days.
