



Hayden Parks and Recreation Beer Garden Proposal

RE: Routt County Fair Beer Garden

The Hayden Parks and Recreation Board would like to organize a beer garden Thursday, August 15th during the bonfire and music performances and Friday, August 16th during the Demolition Derby.

The location of the garden will be a fenced in area with only one entry exit:

- Thursday, August 15th inside the outdoor arena in a marked off area from 6:30 – 11PM.
- Friday, August 16th: Located on the racetrack from the west end of the grandstands to the east end and in the grandstands 6:30 – 11PM.
- Those with alcohol will be allowed to consume in grandstands but not beyond that. Fencing used for the designated alcohol area will restrict any access beyond the designated entry exit (similar to temporary construction fencing). All servers will be Responsible Alcohol Server Trained.

Age Verification and Drink Limits:

Those purchasing an adult beverage will be verified by:

- Requiring current, valid identification that they are over 21 years of age,
- Given a wristband indicating they have been checked.

Signage

- Signage will be posted throughout the area clearly stating that only persons 21 years of age and older whose current identification that has been checked will be allowed to purchase, hold and consume alcohol.

The Hayden Parks and Recreation Board has successfully operated beer gardens in conjunction with our cornhole tournaments as well as at our annual Hayden Daze and the Routt County Fair. Our Board has attended and Board members serving alcohol have been certified with "Responsible Alcohol Server Training" (RAST) through Grand Futures Prevention Coalition. We have not had any issues with unlawful consumption. The Hayden Police Department has been on site at these events and has not had reports of any issues. The Parks and Recreation Board will communicate with local Law Enforcement Officers to ask for extra patrol during sales.

The Hayden Parks and Recreation will be responsible for providing all necessary equipment for operating the beer garden including the serving logistics, storage, ice, tents and wristbands. Servers and many of the additional surveillance volunteers will be Responsible Alcohol Server trained.
