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#### V. BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The Routt County Purchasing Agent collaborated with several Routt County Department Directors and the City of Steamboat Springs Department Directors to create RFI #5: Land Use Management Software in April 2018 to acquire information on the "Best in Class" software solution for both the County and the City internal processes, as well as provide our citizens a user-friendly portal to obtain historical and current data for land use permitting, planning, and licensing.

We sent the RFI to 5 well-known vendors and the evaluation committee selected 4 vendors to receive RFP #617 issued in August 2018. Of those 4, 2 were selected to a full day on-site demonstration and a half-day "hands-on" computer lab open to all the County and City employees and the contractors that would be using the software in the course of business.

The resulting evaluation scoring and bid tabulation are included in the attachments. Of note, the original bids were submitted as a total amount for one solution for both the City and the County; it has been decided by the committee that the City will purchase their own on premise solution maintained by the City IT Department, while the County will purchase a cloud-based solution hosted by CityView.

While this process was over many months, the time and effort of all participants is a true example of the intent to find the best software that will enhance not only the sharing and support of the two municipalities, but offer a streamlined process to all the citizens that need to access this information going forward.
