



CROSSAN'S ELEVATOR FINAL REPORT

This grant was awarded in May 2018 to the Yampa Egeria Historical Society for installation of the elevator to provide handicap access to the second floor of the building. This project was completed in 2018 and the reimbursement requested March of 2019. The total elevator project cost was \$25,843.46 and the MAHFAB grant portion was \$10,000. The \$10,000 reimbursement was received in May 2019.

The pictures that are included are the North side of Crossan's where the elevator is located and the North side of Crossan's showing the elevator location in relationship to the stairwell entrance. These are the same pictures used in the 2018 report because there were no changes.

The building rehabilitation was completed in 2018 and the grand opening was held in September 2018. Thank you to MAHFAB board members who were able to attend. The winter and spring proved interesting – with some heating issues during the winter and some water entering the building in the spring. Things are running more smoothly now. We all thank MAHFAB and the Routt County Commissioners for your support of the project. We couldn't have done it without you. A reminder that the building is multi-use. Visitor Center and Yampa Egeria Historical Society displays, along with Town of Yampa personnel on the first floor and Town offices and meeting room on the second floor. There have been exercise classes, heritage art workshops and historical society meetings on the first floor and several non-profits have used the meeting room on the second floor. Town board meetings are held in the second floor meeting room, also.
