Routt County to Restrict Public Access

March 16, 2020 – To slow the spread of coronavirus, Routt County will be restricting public access to the downtown campus beginning in the next 24 hours.

Effective immediately, public access to the Routt County Courthouse Annex building will not be permitted in order to protect the health and safety of those in our emergency operations center. Offices in the Annex include planning, building, environmental health, public works, and CSU extension.

Effective at 5:00 p.m. on March 17, 2020, public access to the Routt County Courthouse and the Department of Human Services will not be permitted. The Department of Human Services lobby will remain open to meet the critical needs of clients. Members of the public are asked not to come into the Courthouse during the day on the 17th for items that can be completed online or are not critical.

The health of Routt County - including our staff, residents, businesses, and visitors – is critically important to us, so we will be following best practice advice from health experts to reduce contact and public gatherings. Operations will continue via phone and online servicing to the extent possible. Follow up information on accessing individual department's services will be provided as soon as possible.
