**YVRA GRANT APPLICATIONS FOR AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT 2021
(ARPA)**

As announced by the Secretary of Transportation on June 22, 2021, YVRA is eligible for funds under the American Rescue Plan Act 2021 (Public Law 117-2) (ARPA). The purpose of these funds is to provide economic relief to airports in response to the COVID-19 pandemic. The FAA will distribute these grants under the new Airport Rescue Grant Program (ARGP). To distribute these funds, the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) established the Airport Coronavirus Response Grant Program (ACRGP). On 22 Jun 21 the FAA's Denver ADO forwarded grant applications to YVRA for review, approval and processing.

A total of \$6.492B in ARPA funding was allocated for primary airports like YVRA nationwide; individual airport allocations were determined by the FAA:

- YVRA was allocated \$1,853,709 for costs related to operations, personnel, cleaning, sanitization, janitorial services, combating the spread of pathogens at the airport, and debt service payments
- YVRA was also allocated \$90,816 to provide relief from rent and minimum annual guarantees to on-airport parking, on-airport car rental, and in-terminal airport concessions
- YVRA has received and updated the two (2) attached grant applications for submittal to the FAA ADO to receive this ARPA funding
- YVRA must obligate all of these ARPA funds not later than 30 Sep 24

MOTION

Commissioner Redmond moved to approve and authorize for the YVRA Director to sign and submit two (2) grant applications to the FAA for YVRA's allocated American Rescue Plan Act 2021 (ARPA) grant funding.

Commissioner Melton seconded; the motion carried 3-0.
