**A RESOLUTION ORDERING THE TEMPORARY PLACEMENT OF THE PRIDE
FLAG ON COUNTY PROPERTY**

Recitals

1. The Board of County Commissioners of Routt County (the “Board”) stands in solidarity with the LGBTQ+ community and condemns the horrific act of violence that occurred at Club Q in Colorado Springs, Colorado on November 19, 2022; and
2. Desires to promote inclusion, equity, and justice for all persons; and
3. On November 22, 2022, the Board conducted a public hearing following notice as required by law, to consider the adoption of this resolution; and
4. The Board finds that temporary placement of the Pride Flag on County property is government speech within the Board’s authority over County property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Routt County, Colorado that:

1. The Board orders that in order to demonstrate our condemnation against violence, and solidarity with the LGBTQ community, the Pride Flag shall be placed on the Historic Courthouse property commencing on November 21, 2022, for a period of five days as our community mourns with those impacted by the violence in Colorado Springs.
