The City of Steamboat Springs owns and maintains the bear-safe trash cans on Lincoln Ave (Main St.) We also own and maintain historic buildings and have partnered with the Tread of Pioneers Museum on multiple projects. We fully support using vinyl wrap to add informative historic information that is pertinent to downtown Steamboat Springs.
