Steamboat Creates is inviting artists to submit proposals for artwork to be showcased inside the new Routt County Health and Human Services Building, with a theme of "Being Human."

"While the panoramic mountain photos that can be found in both the County Commissioner's Office and Centennial Hall where Steamboat Springs City Council meets are great, the hope is this art would focus more on the human condition," said Julie Kennedy, Routt County Purchasing Manager.

A curatorial committee composed of a diverse and representative group of community members, arts professionals, government and creative district committee members will review proposals.

Proposals are due October 20, 2022 by midnight. Artwork should be ready for installation by mid-April.
